The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.88, dated 23.07.2017, registered under Sections 353, 186, 506, 148, 149 and 379-B of IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioners were granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 18.08.2017.

The husband of petitioner No.1 was an accused in a case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, in which the police party had come to serve non-bailable warrants.

Allegation of the prosecution case is that all ladies and gentlemen surrounded the police and obstructed their act of execution of warrant.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioners are not joined investigation in the matter of obstruction of the execution of the non-bailable warrants against the husband of petitioner no.1.

Looking into the whole background and the non-bailable warrants issued under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, I do not think any

reason to deny the relief granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In that view of the matter interim order dated 18.08.2017 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
