Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 to 8.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioners. As per the office report, notices could not be issued to respondents no.4 to 8 as the counsel for the petitioners has not filed the process fee.

Learned State counsel submits that the police has recorded the statements of the petitioners wherein they have stated that they do not require any protection. He has produced the statements of the petitioners in Court, photocopies of which are taken on record.

As per the statements of the petitioners, they are living happily in the company of each other and have no danger to their life and liberty at the hands of their family members and therefore, they do not require any police protection.

In this view of the matter, no further order is called for in the present petition.

Disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend threat to their life and liberties, they are at liberty to approach respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, who shall redress their grievance, if any, in accordance with law.
