The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.141 dated 17th July, 2017, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 341, 506 and Section 326 (added later on) of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra.

The petitioner has remained in detention for over a month now. He was not originally named in the FIR. His name transpired in a supplementary statement of the complainant, recorded on 18th July, 2017. Considering the nature of his involvement, as described in the supplementary statement, his further detention would not appear to be

called for at this stage. Therefore, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate, concerned, subject to imposition of appropriate terms and conditions as deemed fit and proper for the remaining period of investigation.
