SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioners, who are the accused persons in FIR No.164 dated 12.02.2015 under Sections 467 & 471 of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') registered at Police Station Gurugram City, District Gurugram, have prayed for quashing of FIR with all subsequent proceedings pending in the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram.

During pendency of the trial, the complainant has arrived at a settlement with the accused persons vide compromise Annexure P-2, which is duly signed by him. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The CJM, Gurugram vide report dated 31.01.2017, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any

pressure or coercion.

Respondent No.2 is represented by his counsel.

In view of the report of CJM, Gurugram and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543* and *Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending since the complainant has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioners/accused persons.

In the circumstances, this petition is allowed. FIR No.164 dated 12.02.2015 under Sections 467 & 471 of IPC registered at Police Station Gurugram City, District Gurugram (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
