Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in furtherance of settlement arrived at between the parties, a cheque in a sum of Rs.8.5 lacs was given to the complainant but somehow that could not be honoured. Thereafter, the petitioner has paid Rs.4 lac to the complainant by means of RTGS on 27.02.2017. He intends to pay the remaining amount of Rs.4.5 lac by 30.04.2017.

Learned counsel for the complainant has no objection to the aforesaid course.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sube Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation as

on date but recovery of the balance amount is still to be made.

In view of facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to make the order dated 06.10.2016 absolute subject to the condition that this order will be of no consequence in case remaining amount of Rs.4.5 lacs is not paid by the agreed date i.e. 30.04.2017.

Ordered accordingly.
