Petitioner-Piara Ram has filed this 2nd petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.193 dated 26.09.2016, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala, under Sections 307, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in the FIR. He has been stated to be armed with gun. He fired from his

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gun and the shot hit on the right shoulder of father of the complainant.

The petitioner is the main accused in the FIR.

Though it is a case of version and cross-version, but keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail. Otherwise also, injured etc. have not been examined so far and there is every chance of tampering with the evidence by the petitioner, if he is released on bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner has been in custody since 26.09.2016, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
