The petitioners who are wife and husband have filed these petitions under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.119 dated 08.08.2016 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 & 471 IPC at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to interim order dated 20.09.2016, petitioner-Satpal Singh has deposited the amount of ₹33250/- with the concerned Deputy Commissioner.

The petitioners were granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 02.09.2016 in CRM-M-30907-2016 and order dated 20.09.2016 in CRM-M-31399-2016.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custody is not required.

In view of the fact that the petitioner-Satpal Singh has complied with order dated 20.09.2016 and the further fact that both the petitioners have jointed the investigation, interim order dated 02.09.2016 passed in CRM-M-30907-2016 and interim order dated 20.09.2016 passed in CRM-M-31399-2016, are made absolute.
