The instant writ petition has been filed seeking to challenge the impugned order dated 08.09.2004 by which the services of the petitioner were terminated, on account of the fact that petitioner Mr. Pawan Kumar, was caught accepting illegal gratification of Rs.1000/- from Sarmukh Singh and arrested on 17.06.1996. After conviction by the Special Judge, Ropar, under Sections 7, 13(2) of the P.C. Act, his services were terminated. Against the said conviction, a criminal appeal was preferred in this court i.e. CRA-S-1684-SB-2002, which has too been dismissed.

In view of the fact that the conviction of the petitioner has been upheld, the order of termination cannot be interfered with.

The writ petition stands dismissed.
