Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent nos.5 and 6, who are police officials entered in their house in civil uniform after sunset without lady constable and took away revolver, which was later on shown and an FIR was registered subsequently on 9.5.2016 under Arms Act. Petitioner seeks inquiry into the same. It appears that respondent nos.5 and 6 acted in their official capacity.

Therefore, in these circumstances, the present petition is

disposed of with directions to Superintendent of Police, Hissar to hold an in house inquiry and hear both the parties and then determine as to whether the incident as alleged took place or not and if so what action is to be taken against the defaulting officials at the departmental level. Let inquiry be completed within six months.
