The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.43 dated 27.05.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bakshiwala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had been granted regular bail by the trial Court on 27.11.2015 and had been appearing before the trial Court on every date of hearing except 30.05.2017, whereon, she could not appear as son of the petitioner was admitted in the PGIMER, Chandigarh. Copy of the medical certificate from the PGIMER, Chandigarh in this regard has been annexed as Annexure P-4.

Issue notice to the respondent.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Seena Mand, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

The petitioner is a lady who had been granted regular bail by the trial Court. She is stated to be appearing on every date of hearing ever since the year 2015 and could not appear only on one date as her son was admitted in PGIMER, Chandigarh. It would, therefore, be in the interest of justice, if she is protected from arrest.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall submit bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
