ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.185 dated 26.04.2017, under Section 406 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that the complainant had obtained a loan from the Bank for purchase of a car which was later sold to the petitioner and the petitioner has defaulted in the payment of installments to the Bank. He further states that the petitioner had been granted anticipatory bail by the trial Court by the order dated 03.05.2017 but it was later on cancelled by the order dated 31.05.2017 as the Investigating Officer had informed the Court that the petitioner is not cooperating in the investigation.

This Court, by the order dated 18.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and he was to be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Rohtash, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but he is not making the payment of outstanding amount towards the loan.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, who is present in Court, states that the petitioner shall pay the entire outstanding amount along with the future installments up to 31.12.2017 within a period of 03 months from now.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the order dated 18.08.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall remain bound by his undertaking given before this Court.

The petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
