Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to official respondents to complete the investigation in case FIR No.48 dated 04.03.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FIR in question was registered on 04.03.2017 and even the anticipatory bail filed by the accused was dismissed, but still the investigation in the case is not complete. He further states that speedy justice is the legitimate right of the petitioner and for early completion of the investigation, petitioner has submitted a complaint/representation dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure P-3) to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar i.e. respondent No.2, but no action thereon has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the claim so projected by the petitioner, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar to expedite the investigation in the case.
