On 16.1.2017 following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that provisions of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act were being complied with till 2008 when the respondent-workman was dismissed from service after Departmental enquiry. He is no more in service nor he is being paid the last drawn back wages under Section 17-B of the Act since 2008.

Let notice be issued to respondent No.1 for 15.2.2017.”

According to the petitioner, respondent No.1 was dismissed from service after the departmental enquiry. The dismissal order of the workman dated 5.2.2008 has been placed on record.

In the aforesaid circumstances, we consider it appropriate at this stage to order consignment of the record of the case to record-room with liberty to the parties/legal representatives to get the case revived in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.
