Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 15 dated 01.08.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

It is informed that during the pendency of this petition, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. Petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has since been allowed. It is further informed that CRM-M-29380 of 2017 is pending for quashing of the above said FIR.

Learned counsel for the complainant affirms and verifies the factual position as above submits that her client has no objection, if this petition be allowed.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses

from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.
