Petitioner-Khushpal Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.60 dated 03.04.2017, registered at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been got registered by complainant-Sukhwinder singh Grewal. As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner obtained passport in the name of Sukhwinder Singh Grewal by giving forged documents to the passport office.

Keeping in view the serious allegations levelled against the present petitioner and in view of the fact that he is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
