Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.52 dated 12.05.2017 under Sections 326/341/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

Though initially the FIR was registered under Section 326 IPC, but the said Section was deleted vide DDR No.40 dated 15.05.2017 and Section 325 IPC was added. Later on the offences under Section 307 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, were also added in the FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the injury attributed to the petitioner is not dangerous to life and the same is on

non-vital part of the injured. He further states that during the pendency of present petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhpal Singh, states that the petitioner has caused injury to Pargat Singh which hit on the ankle of the injured.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

So far as the plea of the counsel for the petitioner that the compromise has been entered into between the parties, the same cannot be a ground for anticipatory bail, particularly when the injury is with a gunshot on the injured.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has caused a gunshot injury on the ankle of injured, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out. Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.
