This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of order dated 04.06.2015 passed by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar vide which the petitioners have been summoned to face trial in FIR No.222 dated 24.08.2012 registered under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners informs that three accused were challaned in the present FIR viz. Harjit Singh, Gurnam Singh and Amrik Kaur whereas, Sukhwinder Singh, Gurpreet Singh and Amarjit Kaur @ Pinky were subsequently summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Now, it is asserted that complainant Veena has

joined her matrimonial home, is staying with her husband Harjit Singh and the aforesaid FIR No.222 dated 24.08.2012 along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom have been quashed vide order of even date passed in CRM M-33354 of 2017 qua Harjit Singh, Gurpreet Singh, Gurnam Singh, Amrik Kaur and Amarjit Kaur @ Pinky. Thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
