This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 353 dated 16.12.2016, under Sections 363, 366-A, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of the POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 27.12.2016. It is argued that the petitioner got married with the prosecutrix on 19.12.2016 and approached this Court for protection of their lives and liberty by way of filing CRM-M-45782-2016, in which interim protection has been granted and the case is still pending. It is further contended that the prosecutrix, in her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C., has stated that she would like to reside with the petitioner.

Mr. P. P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application. He submits that there are twenty witnesses and none has been examined so far.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude and the prosecutrix has not supported the prosecution version, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
