ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.335 dated 17.12.2014, under Sections 420, 465, 467 & 471 IPC, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR and the co-accused namely Manjit Singh who was specifically named in the FIR, has been granted anticipatory bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-6233-2015 on 12.05.2015.

This Court, by the order dated 21.08.2017, had directed the petitioners to join investigation and they were to be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation, the order dated 21.08.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
