Petitioner-Satpal Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.45 dated 31.07.2016, registered at Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala, under Sections 302, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the present petitioner whose parents have already died, was brought up

by Amar Kaur (deceased) and her husband-Luchman Singh. The allegation against the present petitioner is that he was pressurizing Amar Kaur to transfer the house in his name. It is also mentioned in the FIR that the present petitioner enticed away Veerpal Kaur and he performed a *karewa* marriage with her and both of them put pressure upon Amar Kaur to transfer the house. As per the FIR, Veerpal Kaur killed old lady-Amar Kaur by giving *gotna* blows in connivance with the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
