This petition under Section 438 Cr. P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.46 dated 26.04.2016, under Sections 406/498-A/354-A IPC, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

As per the report of the Mediation Centre dated 13.01.2017, the dispute has been amicably resolved before the Mediator. It is agreed that Rs.3,00,000 will be given to the respondent-wife towards full and final settlement of alimony and a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act will be filed.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 05.09.2016, passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and

when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
