In the present writ petition, petitioner has sought for a direction to the respondents to offer appointment to the post of Fireman. The petitioner is a candidate for the post of Fireman. For the purpose of eligibility the respondents have notified that one must have experience certificate. Petitioner has produced certificate of Directorate General of Home Guards and Civil Defence, New Delhi. When the selecting and appointing authority verified relating to genuineness of the certificate it was found that it was fake certificate as is evident from communication dated 24.06.2004 (Annexure R/IV). Later on petitioner is stated to have produced one more certificate issued by National Institute of Industrial Security (Annexure P5) dated nil. From these two certificates, it is evident that petitioner has not approached the selecting authority with clean hands. Having regard to the conduct of the petitioner that he has obtained certificate which is not genuine one and which has been verified by the competent authority in the office of Directorate General of Home Guards and Civil Defence, New Delhi. Therefore, petitioner is not entitled for a direction to the respondents to issue offer of appointment to the post of Fireman.

Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed.
