The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 34 dated 19.04.2017, under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Mullanpur Garibdass, District Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as accused on the disclosure statement of co-accused Taranjeet Singh. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 06 months since his arrest on 20.04.2017.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate of the petitioner, which is taken on record. She, however, contends that in terms of the disclosure statement of the co-accused, raid was conducted and 500 grams of Cocaine and 14 grams of Heroin was recovered from the petitioner. Learned State counsel also contends that the investigation has been completed and charges have been framed.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are rather serious as 500 grams of Cocaine, which is five times of the threshold of commercial quantity of 100 grams and 14 grams of Heroin has been recovered from the petitioner. Therefore, it is not a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Consequently the petition is dismissed.
