KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Grievance of the petitioners is that a public road has been destroyed by the private respondents. She wants this Court to order the registration of the FIR for destroying the public road and stealing the bricks of the road measuring one kilometre and 11 feet, the expenses of which were released from the Government funds. Petitioners claim that they had made a representation dated 10.07.2017 (Annexure P-3) to the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur.

In these circumstances, let the petitioners approach the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur with their complaint and if the police fails to take any action in the matter, the petitioners are always at liberty to approach the learned Illaqa Magistrate with a complaint under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. and it is for the Magistrate to take a decision on the matter on merits after examining the documents as to what course of action is to be adopted.
