SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

It has been contended on behalf of the petitioner that the recovery from his house was insignificant being 9 kgs. 800 gms. of poppy husk only whereas the commercial quantity happens to be 50 kgs. Nevertheless, undoubtedly the quantum recovered happens to be substantially higher than “small quantity” as mentioned in the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act which happens to be 1 kg. only.

In the given circumstances, this does not appear to be a fit case to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The petition is, therefore, dismissed.
