The petitioners are seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend threat from respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that date of birth of the petitioner No.1 is 13.05.1988 while the date of birth of the petitioner No.2 is 19.10.1986. The copies of their Aadhaar card and Matriculation certificate, in support thereof, are annexed as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to have solemnized their marriage on 13.08.2017 and the copies of marriage certificate and photographs in this regard are annexed as Annexure P-4 and Annexure P-5, respectively. It is further stated in the petition that the petitioners had also made a representation dated 13.08.2017 (Annexure P-6) to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, but no action has so far been taken thereon.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Seena Mand, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the validity of the marriage and keeping in view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P and another, JT 2006 (6) SC 173**, the present petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar-respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent.
