DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioners seek the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 89, dated 30.11.2015, registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 323 and 34 IPC and Section 135 of Electricity Act, 2003, at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur.

Vide order dated 01.02.2017, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to ad-interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Seeking anticipatory bail for the petitioners, learned counsel submits that the matter between the petitioners and the complainant has been compromised; the petitioners have already discharged their liabilities towards dues payable to the Electricity Department; there is no other criminal case pending against them; even in the FIR only simple injuries are attributed to them and under the interim order passed by this Court, they have not only joined investigation but have fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel while admitting the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and have fully cooperated with the investigating agency submits that at this stage, the petitioners are not needed for further questioning by the investigating agency.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 01.02.2017 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.

During the period that the bail is granted to the petitioners, if they are found indulging in any criminal/illegal activity or misusing the concession of bail granted by this Court, it would be open to the State to move an appropriate application before the competent Court/this Court for cancellation of the bail granted to the petitioners.
