HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for registration of FIR against respondents No.3 to 13 under Sections 323, 324, 307, 326, 120-B and 425 of the Indian Penal Code as the accused have caused injuries to the petitioner.

Prayer has also been made for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.3 to 13.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the aforesaid relief, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 31.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, this Court finds that so far as prayer made by the petitioner for registration of case against respondents No.3 to 13 is concerned, there is a mechanism provided under law and no such direction can be issued under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

However, as regards the prayer of petitioner for protection of his life and liberty is concerned, the respondent No.2 is directed to take note of the contents of representation Annexure P-1 and to act in accordance with law.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
