Counsel for the petitioner and respondent No. 2 are ad idem that in pursuance of the terms and conditions settled between the parties by way of compromise in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the complainant and her husband have already filed a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and an amount of Rs. 25 lakhs has already been paid to the complainant at the time of recording of statements of the parties in first motion. It has further been agreed between the parties that the dowry articles recovered during investigation shall be returned to the husband and his family and the petitioners shall return the original certificates of the complainant lying in their house. It is submitted that the petition may be disposed of with a direction that the parties shall

remain bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise.
