**LISA GILL, J.(ORAL)**

Petitioner seeks concession of bail pending trial in FIR No.717 dated 17.12.2016 registered under Sections 498-A, 304-B, 34 of Indian Penal Code, Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

It is submitted that petitioner who is mother-in-law of the deceased has been implicated in the case merely due to her relationship. It is submitted that no specific allegation has been raised against the present petitioner who has been in custody since 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2017. Moreover, the complainant as well as mother of the deceased have since been examined, therefore, this petition be allowed.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Krishan Kumar, verifies that the complainant (brother of the deceased) as well as mother of the deceased have since testified before the learned trial Court. Seventeen prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined. Petitioner is not reported to be involved in any other case. There are no allegations on behalf of the State that petitioner is likely to abscond or that she is likely to dissuade

the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Trial in this case is not likely to conclude in the near future.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition.

Consequently, the petitioner be released on bail pending trial subject to her furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

It is reiterated that none of the observations made herein above are a reflection on the merits of the case and shall have no bearing on the trial.
