Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.767 dated 05.10.2016, under Sections 406, 419, 465, 467, 468, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Sirsa.

The prosecution allegations are about misappropriation of amount by forgery and fraud in a large scale. Looking to the allegations against the petitioner and having noted the fact that the challan has been filed and further fact that the petitioner had resigned from the Bank on 22.01.2013, I do not think that further detention of the petitioner as under trial is required.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
