Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to transfer the investigation in FIR No.117 dated 23.06.2016 under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran to some other independent agency for fair and impartial investigation.

Along with the status report submitted by way of an affidavit of Piara Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Tarn Taran, an enquiry report dated 28.03.2013 of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, has been filed, wherein it has been stated that the police has considered the statements of respectable persons, documents and statement of doctor under Section 175 Cr.P.C. as well as from his secret and open enquiry, no one was found guilty in

the case and the accused are found innocent. The police has prepared a cancellation report. The report has been submitted for approval to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vipin Kumar, states that in view of the fact that the cancellation report has been prepared and submitted to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, for approval, no interference is warranted.

Having heard counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the fact that police has already prepared the cancellation report, which is awaiting approval from the senior officer, no further cause of action survives to the petitioner.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.

In case, the police submits the cancellation report to the court, the petitioner would be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.
