The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 08.08.2017 passed in Criminal Complaint filed under Sections 499/500 of the Indian Penal Code, whereby non-bailable warrants have been issued for securing his presence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier bailable warrants for securing the presence of the petitioner were issued on 26.05.2017 but the petitioner could not appear in Court due to illness, although he was duly represented by his counsel. Learned counsel further states that it was due to the illness of the petitioner that he was prevented from appearing in Court and the petitioner would appear in Court on the next date of hearing.

As the petition is only for setting-aside the non-bailable warrants for securing the presence of the petitioner, I do not deem it necessary to issue notice to the respondents. The petitioner had been represented through his counsel and had

intimated the Court regarding his illness. He, therefore, deserves another chance to appear before the Court by submitting hisailable warrants.

Consequently, the order dated 08.08.2017 shall be held in abeyance and the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on the next date of hearing and submit his bail bonds. However, in case the petitioner does not appear before the trial Court on the next date of hearing and submit his bail bonds, the order dated 08.08.2017 shall stand revived.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
