Learned State counsel, on instructions, and counsel for the complainant, both submit that the person stated to be an eye witness of the occurrence has also now been examined and only a formal witness remains to be examined on 21.04.2017. The said person is stated to be Sub Inspector Satwant Singh.

Consequently, this would not be a stage to grant bail to the petitioner. However, the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, is directed to ensure that the aforesaid Sub Inspector Satwant Singh duly appears to depose before the trial Court on 21.04.2017, failing which the petitioner would be at liberty to file another petition seeking bail.

Obviously, if such petition is filed, the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, would be required to answer as to why a police official is not

appearing in response to Court summons.
