Petitioner-Harpreet Singh @ Jyoti has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.25 dated 26.03.2016, registered at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala, under Sections 302, 307 and 34 IPC and Sections 120-B, 148, 149, 323, 324, 325 and 326 IPC, added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, it is a case of honour killing. Veerpal Kaur and her husband were attacked

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by Bhola Singh and other persons. The present petitioner is stated to be cousin of Veerpal Kaur and has been named by her. In the present case, Baljit Singh, husband of Veerpal Kaur has been killed and Veerpal Kaur has also received injuries.

The case is at the preliminary stage and statements of eye-witnesses etc. have not been recorded so far. Furthermore, there is every possibility that if the petitioner is released on bail, he may tamper with the evidence.

Therefore, no ground is made out to grant the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
