Grievance of the petitioner is that she was enrolled enrolled by respondent nos.4 and 5 in PG College of Education, Sanoli Road, Nimbri, District Panipat but when final examination roll number was not received. She came to know that she was not formally enrolled as a student and her admission papers were not sent to the University.

Stand of respondent nos.4 and 5 is that the petitioner was never granted any admission. In fact, there were 100 seats and the identify card of the petitioner shows that her roll number is 101. She was casually allowed to attend the classes as some writ petition was pending before this Court, therefore, she was told that she will be enrolled if High Court allowed the writ petition. The writ petition was ultimately dismissed. The receipt of first two installments of fee in December 2015 is not denied. For the third

installment, it is stated that it was not received but deposited in the bank account of the college.

The State in the reply has reported that after an inquiry it has come to conclusion that no criminal offence is made out.

The prayer of the present petitioner in this petition is to order the police to register a case and file status report. Status report has already been filed by way of reply.

In these circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to seek appropriate remedy of claiming compensation or filing criminal case before competent Court.

The present petition stands dismissed with aforesaid liberty.
