On 31.01.2017, following order was passed by this

Court:-

*“Contends that no case under Section 436
IPC is made out. Learned counsel refers to
preliminary inquiry report (Annexure P- 1) wherein
no employee was held responsible for causing fire
allegedly attributed to the petitioner.*

Notice of motion for 27.03.2017.

*Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the
petitioner by the Arresting Officer, she shall be
released on interim bail subject to the following
conditions:-*

- 1. That she shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. That she shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3. That she shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in pursuance of aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Som Nath, Vigilance Bureau, Tarn Taran and further stated that he is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 31.01.2017 is hereby made absolute.
