Petitioner-Ajmer Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.02 dated 04.01.2017, registered at Police Station Civil Line, Bathinda, District Bathinda, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record. Police record is also perused.

From the record, I find that allegation against the present petitioner is that he alongwith Satnam Singh got the mutation of inheritance cancelled by forging an affidavit.

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All the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. The petitioner has been in custody since 18.05.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
