Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.91 dated 24.06.2017 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 22.08.2017, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation. Learned counsel for the complainant has also submitted that there is a possibility of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.08.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
