The petitioner has challenged the order dated 01.07.2015 (Annexure P-1), whereby he has been declared a proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act was filed against the petitioner in the year 2013. He further contends that the petitioner is residing at his Village Shivdaspur, Post Office Kartarpur, District Jalandhar, while the address in the proclamation in pursuance to the Court order is mentioned as Post Office Mustafapur and, therefore, he has not been served at the address, where he has been residing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance to the interim order dated 22.08.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and

submitted his bail bonds on 08.09.2017 to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner will appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.

Heard.

The petitioner has been residing at his address in Village Shivdaspur Post Office Kartarpur, District Jalandhar while the address in the proclamation is mentioned as Post Office Mustafapur. The petitioner has now appeared before the trial Court and submitted his bail bonds.

Consequently, the impugned order dated 01.07.2015 is hereby set-aside. The petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date and shall not absent himself except with prior permission from the Court.
