ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.14 dated 13.06.2017 under Section 307/34/120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station State Special Operation Cell Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations in the FIR are that co-accused of the petitioner namely Sahilpreet Singh @ Sahil had fired at the police party when they were asked to stop at the police nakka. She further contends that one pistol along with four cartridges is stated to have been recovered from the petitioner and another pistol along with three cartridges was recovered from the dashboard of the car.

Learned counsel further contends that no injury was caused to anyone in the alleged firing and the petitioner is not involved in any other case. He is stated to be in custody ever since his arrest on 13.06.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, submits that investigation has been completed and challan has been filed in Court on 12.09.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that investigation has already been completed and the petitioner is in custody for over four months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Ranjodh Singh @ Rana is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
