Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.45 dated 16.06.2017 under Sections 323, 324 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 22.08.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinderjit Singh does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.08.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
