By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.08 dated 12.01.2017, registered under Sections 354, 323 and 506 of IPC, at Police Station Laddowal, District Ludhiana City.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance of order dated 07.02.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

Though the order dated 07.02.2017 reads that meantime,

arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed, however, the learned State counsel admits that the petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.02.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
