This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 77 dated 27.05.2017, under Sections 306 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that no offence under Section 306 IPC is made out and the petitioner is in custody since 27.05.2017. It is contended deceased Raj Kala committed suicide on an apprehension that her husband was having an extra marital affair with the petitioner herein. It is also contended that chargesheet has been filed and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude.

Mr. P. P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application. He opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner, however, is not in a position to dispute the arguments raised by the counsel for the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the

fact that the petitioner is in custody since 27.05.2017 and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, any opinion expressed herein is for the purpose of grant of regular bail and not an opinion on the merits of the case.
