ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of Rapat No.29 dated 26.05.2016, recorded in FIR No.32 dated 26.05.2016, under Sections 323,325,148,149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar on the basis of compromise which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the residents of the same village, which has now been resolved with the intervention of the respectables.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 22.08.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Phillaur, District Jalandhar Jhajjar dated

06.09.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the residents of the same village, which has now been resolved with the intervention of the respectables.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and Rapat No.29 dated 26.05.2016 recorded in FIR No.32 dated 26.05.2016, under Sections 323,325,148,149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
