Petitioner has come up in revision against the order dated 28.07.2015 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Jalandhar, whereby application filed by the prosecution under Section 311 Cr.P.C. has been dismissed. Further prayer has been made to set aside the order dated 20.09.2016 (Annexure P-8) dismissing an application under Section 173 (8) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that originally, a complaint was made by the petitioner and subsequently, on a reminder, the present FIR was registered. By way of application under Section 311 Cr.P.C., the prosecution is seeking to produce the first complaint, which is not part of the police file. The allegations in the reminder and even in the FIR are with respect to the offence under Section 509 IPC.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of

the view that the applications filed by the prosecution/complainant under

Section 173 (8) Cr.P.C. and under Section 311 Cr.P.C. have rightly been dismissed by the trial Court. No ground is made out to interfere in the impugned orders.
