RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 1 dated 04.01.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector-20, Panchkula, District Panchkula and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 17.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 22.08.2017, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Panchkula and got recorded their statements qua compromise.

Report from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Panchkula, vide covering

letter No. 604 dated 07.09.2017, duly forwarded by learned District and

Sessions Judge, Panchkula, vide letter No. 2416-J dated 07.09.2017, has also been received. According to the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Panchkula, the compromise between the parties is voluntary, genuine, and without any pressure.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the petition is accepted and the aforesaid FIR No. 1 dated 04.01.2017 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners, is quashed.
