The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 156 dated 14.07.2017, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a monetary dispute between the parties and the matter has been compromised with the complainant. Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed affidavit of the complainant with regard to the compromise, which is taken on record. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner has been in custody for over 02 months since the date of his arrest on 14.07.2017.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

Heard.

The FIR is the outcome of a monetary dispute, which has now been resolved. The petitioner is in custody for over two

months. I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Darshan Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
