Ld. Counsel for the complainant submits that there is no possibility of any amicable settlement with the petitioner, who is very evasive qua returning of the equipment delivered to his Firm and even payment of the requisite accrued amount.

2. In the earlier order passed on 01.11.2017, it has already been noted that the petitioner's contention of not being connected with the affairs of the Firm “Inder Timber Traders” is not convincing, since the available material in the Police Case Diary indicates that not only the petitioner had

been operating the Bank Account of the said Firm, but even closed it by making a final withdrawal on 19.07.2017.

3. The other contention raised on behalf of the petitioner that the F.I.R. does not describe him as proprietor of the Firm is also not convincing. It is settled law that the F.I.R. is not meant to be an Encyclopedia narrating each and every fact in specific detail.

4. Suffice it to say, undeniably the petitioner happens to be the own father of Varun Raikhy, who was specifically named as owner/proprietor of the Firm, and who is an absconder for a very long time. He could not be apprehended till date, inspite of all the steps resorted to by the Authorities.

5. In such circumstances, and considering the active association of the petitioner with the accused-Firm, this does not appear to be a fit case to grant him the benefit of interim bail.

6. The concession of interim bail granted earlier to the petitioner vide order dated 28.08.2017 stands withdrawn.

7. Dismissed.
