Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.32 dated 01.06.2017, under Sections 324, 323, 341, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot. This Court had made an order dated 23.08.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from police official, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and custody is not required.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 23.08.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
